Supplies: • Math Notebook (spiral or loose-leaf) • Math Folder • Pencil • Calculator (TI-30 recommended)

Expectations:

- Be in your seat when the bell rings.

- Give your attention to Algebra for the entire class period.
Take notes, work examples, work on assignments until work time ends.
If you finish your assignment early, work on material from another class.

- Get/ask for help before you fall behind: use the Math Resource Center/after school tutoring/your teacher.
- Electronic devices and related equipment will not be used during class.

Attendance:

- You are expected to be in class every day. Regular attendance is essential for success in mathematics.
- You are expected to ask for make-up work in advance for pre-excused absences such as field trips, sports, and vacations.
- Make-up Work: Students have 2 days to complete missed work/tests or to make arrangements with the teacher for each day of an **excused** absence.
- Missing class on a pre-excused absence such as a field trip or family vacation is not a valid reason for postponing an assignment or test.

Grading Policy:

- The grading scale is as follows: A: 90-100% B: 80-89.99% C: 70-79.99% D: 60-69.99% I/F: 0-59.99%
- Quarter grades are weighted:
40%: Quizzes
30%: Participation/Assignments
30%: Tests
- Semester Grade: Quarter 1 – 45% Quarter 2 – 45% Semester Final – 10%
- Quizzes: Each quiz can be retaken **once** if your score is less than 75%. Quiz corrections and scheduling of retakes must be done within 5 days of when it is given back. On any retake the highest score received will be a 75%.
- Participation/Assignments: This can be anything including but not limited to: in class work, take home assignments, attendance, late work, coming to class prepared, group participation, willingness to answer questions, and being productive during work time. If you have questions, talk to your teacher.
- Tests: There will be chapter tests and cumulative tests. These will not be retaken.
